Postdoctoral Program Admissions

Below you will find important information to assist potential applicants in assessing their likely fit with the post-doctoral psychology residency training program at Citrus Health Network. This description is consistent with the program's policies on resident selection and practicum and academic preparation requirements:

The Citrus Health Network Psychology Postdoctoral Residency Program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of the American Psychological Association (APA) and is a member of the Association of Psychology Postdoctoral and Internship Centers (APPIC). Treatment experiences in a broad array of programs: Children's Crisis Stabilization Unit (CCSU); Adult Crisis Stabilization Unit (ACSU); Foster Care Programs; Outpatient Psychotherapy; Behavioral Medicine; Statewide Inpatient Psychiatric Program (SIPP); Training in the area of Clinical Psychology with the goal of preparing candidates for licensure and subsequent Board Certification. This program offers: A rich program of didactic seminars, colloquia & supervision with a large faculty body; Emphasis in the integration of science and practice with sensitivity to cultural diversity; and individual differences; A multiethnic, largely Hispanic population; Opportunity for program development, training and expansion; Opportunity to gain experience in supervising others; Opportunity to conduct research. Residents who complete the program successfully earn a certificate in Clinical Psychology.

Program Aims: 1) To increase and refine resident's ability to integrate clinical theory and practice in the application of knowledge, assessment, and clinical skills in the practice of psychology. 2) To use critical thinking to identify and respond to diversity. 3) To heighten the resident's sense of professionalism.

Competencies: Integration of Science and Practice; Individual and Cultural Diversity; Ethical and Legal Standards and Policy; Education and Systems.
